Dear Mr. Lucas:

Your letter to State Surgeon General Ana Viamonte Ros was forwarded to our bureau's attention. In response to your question in that letter, the Department of Health does not have any laws, codes or regulations requiring patrons in restaurants, retail establishments, grocery stores and the like to wear shoes or other footwear.

Please be aware there are other agencies in the state that regulate certain businesses, particularly food establishments. Although we do not believe those agencies have any requirements of this nature, you may want to contact them directly. Those agencies are the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR), which regulates restaurants and the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (DACS), which regulates grocery stores.
