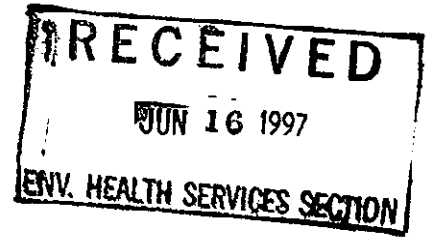

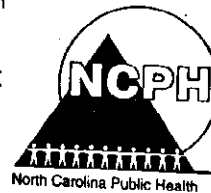
In North Carolina, to your knowledge, are there health codes requiring customers in shops, markets, or restaurants to have on footwear? If so, could you cite these laws/regulations?
