Thank you for contacting the Region of Peel – Public Health.

We regularly inspect businesses for compliance with public health related legislation, however, the legislation applies to the food operator and its employees. The businesses we inspect include food premises (e.g., restaurants), personal service settings, day nurseries, public pools and spas, and tobacco and electronic cigarette retailers.

Business may also have dress code policies in place and that is at the business owner's discretion. **There is no legislation enforced by Public Health regarding dress code of customers.** You may contact the Manager of the business to learn more about their policies or contact head office and file a complaint.
